COURT RELEASES SLAHI DECISION

Last month, we talked about Judge James
Robertson's decision that Mohamedou Slahi should
be released. Robertson's order has now been
released. I'll have comments as I read it. But
the short version is that the Government
abandoned its attempt to prove (first) that
Slahi had knowledge of 9/11 before it happened,
and (second) that any material support he had
offered al Qaeda had effectively ended by the
time they picked him up.

I'll have more as I read this, but just as a reminder, this is the guy for whom Donald Rumsfeld developed a special interrogation plan including death threats.
