## A BILL

To give subpoen power to the National Commission on the BP Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill and Offshore Drilling.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. SUBPOENA POWER OF THE NATIONAL COMMIS4 SION ON THE BP DEEPWATER HORIZON OIL
5 SPILL AND OFFSHORE DRILLING.
6 (a) SUBPOENA POWER.—The National Commission
7 on the BP Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill and Offshore
8 Drilling established by Executive Order No. 13543 of May
9 21, 2010 (in this section referred to as the "Commis-

1	sion"), may issue subpoenas to compel the attendance and
2	testimony of witnesses and the production of books,
3	records, correspondence, memoranda, and other docu-
4	ments.
5	(b) Issuance.—
6	(1) AUTHORIZATION.—A subpoena may be
7	issued under this section only—
8	(A) by agreement of the Co-Chairs of the
9	Commission; or
10	(B) by the affirmative vote of a majority of
11	the members of the Commission.
12	(2) SIGNATURE AND SERVICE.—A subpoena
13	issued under this section may be issued under the
14	signature of either Co-Chair or any member des-
15	ignated by a majority of the Commission, and may
16	be served by any person designated by the Co-Chairs
17	or a member designated by a majority of the Com-
18	mission.
19	(c) Enforcement.—
20	(1) REQUIRED PROCEDURES.—In the case of
21	contumacy of any person issued a subpoena under
22	this section or refusal by such person to comply with
23	the subpoena, the Commission shall request the At-
24	torney General to seek enforcement of the subpoena.
25	Upon such request, the Attorney General shall seek

1 enforcement of the subpoena in a court described in 2 paragraph (2). The court in which the Attorney 3 General seeks enforcement of the subpoena shall 4 issue an order requiring the subpoenaed person to 5 appear at any designated place to testify or to produce documentary or other evidence, and may 6 7 punish any failure to obey the order as a contempt 8 of that court. 9 (2) Jurisdiction for enforcement.—Any 10 United States district court for a judicial district in 11 which a person issued a subpoena under this section

resides, is served, or may be found, or where the

subpoena is returnable, shall have jurisdiction to en-

force the subpoena as provided in paragraph (1).
