4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the  
5 date of enactment of this Act, the Inspector General of  
6 the Department of Justice shall commence an assessment  
7 to determine—

8 (1) whether the Department of Justice has  
9 issued any legal opinions authorizing the targeted

1       killing of citizens of the United States located in the  
2       United States or abroad; and

3               (2) whether any such opinions comply with  
4       Federal law and the Constitution of the United  
5       States.

6       (b) ISSUANCE OF REPORT.—Not later than 1 year  
7       after the date of enactment of this Act, the Inspector Gen-  
8       eral of the Department of Justice shall submit to the Com-  
9       mittee on the Judiciary of the Senate and the Committee  
10      on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives and pub-  
11      lically release a report detailing the findings of the assess-  
12      ment conducted under subsection (a).
