

THE INHERENT CONFLICT OF INTEREST WITH DOJ'S OPR AND DAVID MARGOLIS

The first, and most obvious, issue of conflict with OPR is that it places evaluation and resolution of ethical complaints against DOJ attorneys in the hands of the DOJ. The power to determine whether there is any impropriety is solely within the hands of those supervising and/or ultimately responsible for the impropriety.
