SCOTUS SIDES WITH SECRETARY OF STATE BRUNNER

It appears that SCOTUS has ruled with Ohio's Secretary of State Jennifer Brunner (and overturned one of the politicized 6th Circuit Court's decisions) that she should not have to alert county officials to newly registered voters whose records don't exactly match state records.

The Supreme Court is siding with Ohio's top elections official in a dispute with the state Republican Party over voter registrations.
