19	"(2) Obtainable types of information and
20	RECORDS.—The information and records described
21	in this paragraph are the following:
22	"(A) Name, physical address, e-mail ad-
23	dress, telephone number, instrument number,
24	and other similar account identifying informa-
25	tion.

"(B) Account number, login history, length
of service (including start date), types of serv-
ice, and means and sources of payment for
service (including any card or bank account in-
formation).
"(C) Local and long distance toll billing
records.
"(D) Internet Protocol (commonly known
as 'IP') address or other network address, in-
cluding any temporarily assigned IP or network
address, communication addressing, routing, or
transmission information, including any net-
work address translation information (but ex-
cluding cell tower information), and session
times and durations for an electronic commu-
nication.".
SEC Section 6001 of the Intelligence Reform
and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 (50 U.S.C. 1801
note) is amended by striking subsection (b).
